Board Vice Chair Robert Emrich called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Dr. Goodnow called on Pam Clark and Leanne Govitz to present an overview of plans for the celebration of the college's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Pam Clark recognized the work of Andrea Techlin and Sydnee Whitehead in putting the presentation together.

Pam Clark and Leanne Govitz presented a Powerpoint which reached back to the beginnings of the College, with film clips from the first Board of Trustees meeting, photographs of faculty, students and staff from the opening of the college in September 1961 with 1800 students through film clips of persons who were instrumental in the college's formation: Bob Sherman of Bay City, Henry Marsh of Saginaw, Ned Brandt of Midland, Paul Rowley of Bay City, and Ranny Riecker of Midland.

They reviewed the philosophy and goals of the yearlong celebration, building knowledge of and affinity for Delta College, describing the committees in place, special projects planned, budget, key community events, the campus environment with entrance door decals, banners on parking lot light poles, hallway window murals, presentation panels, and the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary website, and pointed out the kickoff events planned for January 18-25.

There being no further business, the dinner meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
