## Accreditation

Delta College is a community college that awards both Associate Degrees and Certificates in transfer and occupational areas. Delta College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The College is an "A" rating in the "Report of Credit Given" of the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers. Students who have met the requirements for either agreement will have appropriate designation on the transcript.

#### **College Calendar**

Delta College operates on the trimester system with three 15-week semesters yearly. Credit hours on transcripts are semester hours.

#### Advance Transfer Credit

Transfer credits awarded appear on the transcript, but are not included in the computation of the grade point average. Courses with grades of C or above at 100 or 200 level are considered for transfer equivalency credit.

"P" (Pass) credit is granted and represents performance at or above the "C" (2.0) level. "NC" (No Credit) means no credit is granted and represents performance at or below "C-" (1.7) level.

## **Below 100 Level Coursework**

Courses below 100 level are not utilized towards fulfillment of graduation requirements.
